Alebrijes are hand carved and painted figures of real and imaginary fauna and flora traditionally created in the State of Oaxaca, Mexico. These colorful and creative works are mostly carved out of copal, a tree that provides soft wood for the art and incense for their traditional religious offerings. The quality of an alebrije depends on the originality of the design, the number of pieces comprising the work, the quality of the carving and the detail and intricacy of the painting.

Alebrije art is a Mexican trademark and is distinctive among the Oaxacan communities. In San Pedro Taviche, alebrije art allows the natives to represent their fauna and flora with a touch of magic and extravagance that manifests their inner feelings. The artistic process also allows them to develop and strengthen their social fabric since families work collectively in the creation of these pieces; these works may be their only source of income. Not only is the Alebrije craft a demonstration of the skilled artistry of the Oaxacan natives but also is an expression of good will and hope for a better future.

Aura Silver Resources, following its Corporate Social Responsibility principles, has established partnerships with its stakeholders in San Pedro Taviche to support their sustainable development while conducting mineral exploration in the area. The present exposition of alebrijes crafted by the artisans of San Pedro Taviche provides our partners an opportunity to present their work to a new market.
